


3	If applicable, check tank pressure via schrader valve. Correct as needed.	●		

Note: The technician shall perform any repairs identified during PM up to \$250 (direct labor and direct materials) exceeding \$250 open a corrective maintenance (CM) ticket and include the Asset #, WO #, photos, and a description of the repair.
