Description of Repairs

- Drill hall not heating
- o Found no power to drill hall control panels
- o Found breaker in drill hall breaker panel in the off position
- o Crystal stated that the solders turn the units off during drill because of their noise. It appears they may have turned off the entire system using the breaker for this reason. If noise is an issue I would recommend servicing the units belts and bearings
- o It is also recommended to either secure the breaker or breaker panel to prevent any further unauthorized control
- HRUs not running
- o Found no communication between Ciper-10 controllers and the Jace; all Niagara network security certificates expired and the controllers refused their respective Niagara connections.
- o I approved the expired certificates to be used by controllers and the units are now running nominally
- o It should be noted that the HRUs, Hot Water, and OMS controllers all require active Niagara network connections between the controllers themselves as well as the JACE to operate properly. I made a note in the graphics and added status points as a reminder
- o Controls system preventative maintenance is a good way to prevent these types of issues in the future
