3	Check all connections - electric, gas and water. Tighten as necessary.	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>		
4	Check operation and setting of aquastat. Check hot water temperature with dial thermometer, and set aquastat at minimum value required for all uses.	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>		
5	Clean water heater exterior.	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>		
6	Clean pump, controls, switches, and starters. Check operation of pump and condition of pump seal or packing, and replace as required.	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>		
7	Soap test for gas leaks, if leaks are found notify facility manager and AFOS immediately.	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>		
8	Clean up work area and remove trash.	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/>
